



Mike Moran MBE – Chief Executive Office

Mike is one of the founders of Proton Partners International. He formed the Company in February 2015 and led the successful fund raise of £130m equity and £30m debt. He is now overseeing the deployment of the capital to build five cancer centres across the UK. Each cancer centre will have imaging, chemotherapy, radiotherapy, and proton beam therapy.

Mike has significant experience, and a proven track record, in developing early start-up businesses with the potential for rapid growth. He has excellent vision and the ability to transform complexity into simplicity. His expertise has been key to the staggering start that Proton Partners has made since its formation. The Company has bought a building, it has three construction projects through planning and underway, two additional centres pending planning approval/application, it has ordered six IBA Proteus One proton beam therapy machines, three Elekta linear accelerators, three Philips CT scanners and one Philips PET CT scanner and, it is in the process of agreeing commercial terms on two additional sites.

Mike was born in the City of Liverpool in 1960 and attended Alsop High School, Liverpool. He joined the Army in 1982, serving in the Falkland Islands, South Georgia, Bosnia, Kosovo, the Middle East and Germany. Since retiring from the Armed Forces in 2001, Mike has been involved in a number of successful businesses, primarily in the defence and healthcare sectors, operating in national and international markets.

Mike has served as Chairman of Herefordshire and Worcestershire Learning and Skills Council where he oversaw £60m of capital projects within the two Counties. He has also served as Chairman of Herefordshire & Worcestershire Chamber of Commerce, Chairman of Herefordshire & Worcestershire Chamber of Commerce Investment Syndicate and as a fundraiser for The Royal National College for the Blind in Hereford.

Mike has a philanthropic nature and in 2008 he established a sports foundation. The focus of the sports foundation is to support the development of young people through sport. Over the years, the sports foundation has supported army skiing, numerous football teams, the British Biathlon Union and the International Taekwon-do Federation of England (ITF England). Mike helped ITF England successfully bid to host the European Taekwon-Do Championships in Liverpool in April 2017.

In 2010 Mike received the MBE in The Queen's Birthday Honours list, for Service to Business. Mike enjoys skiing and martial arts; he follows Liverpool Football Club and finds time to jog in his spare time.
