Dr Liz Bishop is the Chief Executive of The Clatterbridge Cancer Centre NHS Foundation Trust. Liz was a cancer nurse specialising in bone marrow transplant before moving into senior clinical and managerial roles. She joined Clatterbridge in 2018 from The Royal Marsden NHS Foundation Trust in London, where she was Deputy CEO and Chief Operating Officer. Liz has led Clatterbridge through an exciting time as it achieved a major milestone in its 60-year history and for cancer care in Cheshire & Merseyside, with the opening of the spectacular new state-of-the-art Clatterbridge Cancer Centre – Liverpool. Professor Carlo Palmieri is a Consultant in Medical Oncology at The Clatterbridge Cancer Centre and a Professor in Translational Oncology at the University of Liverpool. Carlo's academic and clinical interest is in breast cancer and he is actively involved in developing and initiating translational and clinical research trials. Carlo is currently leading a clinical study, funded by NIHR, UKRI and the Clatterbridge Cancer Charity, into clinical outcomes for people with the Covid-19 infection and different kinds of cancer. With almost 7,000 patients with both confirmed cancer and COVID-19 diagnoses already enrolled for this study, it will be one of the world's largest and most detailed studies of its kind.
